Weeding In The Garden Of Your Soul

We are fortunate in this country to have many Stately Homes. A number of them are still inhabited by the same families that built them many centuries ago but, in most cases, this does not stop them from being open to the public. Both the National Trust and English Heritage make sure that the Homes are maintained to a first rate standard. It maybe that you make a bee-line for the House and spend many an hour looking at the treasures within of art, furniture and design. How many spend as much time looking at the beautifully kept gardens? I always make sure that I explore the gardens and wonder at the immaculate flowerbeds, trees and shrubs and, if I am lucky, I may be able to speak to one of the gardeners who always seem to be endlessly keeping everything up to a high standard. The conversation with the gardener(s) soon turns to practical maintenance. What is common to all is that no matter how well kept the flowerbeds are, there is a constant battle with weeds; each day there is a task to be done in weeding out those unwanted "flowers in the wrong place".

I wonder if a gardener went to the doctor and informed him that he was suffering from a severe complaint called Lolium Temulentum from which most people in the country suffer, I wonder what he would think? Well, let me explain, in the Gospel for this Sunday there is certainly a lot of it about. Lolium Temulentum is the Latin name for what was sown in the man's field of wheat - Darnel (you may remember it as sticky arrow a common grass which you could take off the head and throw it like an arrow at someone and it would stick in their hair or on their clothes). The problem is that it looks like wheat but is highly poisonous. The double effect is intended by the evil one next door to ruin the crop by deception and by its poisonous effect.

I find this parable so helpful in my own life where the weeds of sin grow side by side with the desire to have a fruitful and worthy Christian life. We are reminded that we all have to face this nasty neighbour, Mr Evil, who will sow the poisonous seeds of deception wherever goodness seeks to grow and flourish. I like the idea that as we grow we learn to identify our sins more clearly, and, as Jesus continues to tell us, that when you do recognise them, you must pull them out, cast them aside and burn them up! How? Through Penitence in the act of Sacramental Confession. The weeds are pulled out but as every gardener knows in time they will come back, but, we shall go again and again to ask for forgiveness and take the only effective medicine for Lolium Temulentum.... I suggest you take one dose at least every month. You will be surprised how immediate the remedy works and you will feel better instantly.
