This Holiday Cost an Arm and a Leg!

This year for the first time I took a holiday after Easter with all my brothers (we didn't do this in Hungary). We went to Venice for a few days. The apartments there are not cheap, but in the end we only had to pay for the trip, because we received the house courtesy of a friend, so we did not have to pay for accommodation.

We toured many churches of Venice, between a Tintoretto, a Titian and a Palma Vecchio, we filled our eyes and hearts with wonderful paintings, with images representing the history of salvation that were truly beautiful and majestic.

But at a certain point I started to see badly... at first just a little soot, then the soot gradually increased, until with one eye I could see everything very dimly and could no longer distinguish objects. So I went to a hospital to get checked out and there they told me that I had to undergo surgery to fix a retinal detachment. The doctor told me that surgery for this isn't too complicated, however as it is a surgical procedure, there is a chance that it could fail and I may lose the sight in one eye. At that moment I was a bit afraid, I thought of how my life and lifestyle would change. In short, I had a series of worries related to the outcome of the operation, until I came out of the room where I had my check-up, and in the waiting room saw again the faces of my brothers: Fr Luca, Fr Raffaele and Dcn Matteo. At that moment the anxiety passed, because their presence immediately reminded me of the presence of Another. I felt their being there at that difficult moment like the embrace of Jesus who told me: "Don't worry, I am with you". So from that point on I carried on with my holiday with difficulty because with one eye I couldn't see, but from a spiritual point of view I was in peace.

I knew that the NHS has biblical waiting times, so my only remaining concern was: When am I going to have surgery? Will I have to wait that long and will my eye be ruined in the meantime?

As soon as I got home, I went straight to Southampton (Saturday afternoon) and there, after my check-up, they scheduled my urgent operation for Sunday morning. So I had one more confirmation that I am not alone, that I am loved, that the only concern I have to have is to follow Jesus with all my being, to surrender myself to Him.

You may ask, but what does the title of this front page have to do with all this? You will understand if you translate this English saying into Italian. When you want to emphasise that something costs a lot, in Italian you say it costs an eye of the head.

So I really must admit that this holiday costed me an eye of the head, though not because of the money, but because one eye didn't work. But on the other hand, this misfortune has put my heart back into what matters in life, made me rediscover in Jesus the greatest treasure I have. So my advice to readers, even without becoming half-blind, is to rediscover the primary importance of Jesus' presence and love in your life, above all else, even your health!
