LOOKING FORWARD – LOOKING BACK

'Looking forward' must be one of the most frequent things that we do and say in our lives. We may be looking forward this week to meeting an old friend, planning a holiday, starting a new hobby or just having some quiet time to ourselves.

As children most of our looking forward is to the very immediate future, although I'm sure we all remember milestone moments of great excitement and anticipation like the build-up to Christmas. As we grow into the teenage years and then adulthood our 'looking forward' takes on the important concerns of education for the world of work, building a lifelong relationship, recognising a vocation or progressing a career, buying a home and achieving independence. We are so occupied with these developments that we probably look forward more than we look back.

In middle age we are focussed on our family, our career or vocation, our hobbies and interests. We also have to consider that our parents are getting older too. We have to face the reality of illness and death among our relatives which reminds us of our past, our upbringing, the debt of gratitude we owe to others.

When retirement comes our attitudes have probably shifted quite considerably. No longer do we have to consider promotion prospects or a full-time job. While we look forward to having more time for hobbies and leisure, volunteering in the parish, seeing the grandchildren growing up, we also have time to look back on our lives and to reflect on all that has happened to us.

As we enter November our thoughts turn to those who have gone before us. On All Souls' Day we pray for family, friends and parishioners who have died; we remember by name and light a candle for those who have died within the past year. On the national Remembrance Day we give thanks to all whose lives were sacrificed for us in the name of right and freedom. We visit our cemeteries and churchyards to pray at the graves of people from our local communities. While November is the special month for remembrance, we know too that those who have died are remembered at every Mass that is celebrated, every day, across the world; and in the Evening Prayer of the Church the final intercession is offered each day for those who have died.

You will see elsewhere in the newsletter the days and times that our churches in the parish are open for private prayer. It is a great Catholic tradition for people to pop into the church to pray before the Blessed Sacrament as they go about their daily life. Perhaps this is something we might be able to do during November: to make a personal visit to the church for say, fifteen minutes, to make an Act of Gratitude for the lives of all those we have known, remembering them by name. They are the ones who, in so many different ways, have helped to shape us to be the people we are today. If getting to the church is not possible then you might find a quiet space at home for this prayer of remembrance. We all have so many people to be grateful for, so let us 'look back' as well as looking forward.

Eternal rest grant to them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them; may they rest in peace. Amen.
