#### THIS AND THAT: THOUGHTS ON HOLIDAY

I have just returned from two weeks in "sunny" Exmouth, Devon. My Grandparents on my Father's side, and an Uncle and Aunt, on my Mother's side, lived in Exmouth and my brother and I spent many a childhood holiday in this beautiful town at the mouth of the river Exe in South Devon. I was able to re-visit the places where we explored rock-pools, jumped off cliffs into the water and fished from the harbour wall. This holiday, however, was composed of brisk walks along the Esplanade and enjoying the space to read and catch up with ones thoughts. Three of these random thoughts I would like to share with you.

I heard someone call another person a *crackpot* - an expression which has gone out of fashion these days. I think they were suggesting that the person was a little mad or eccentric. Cracks might be dangerous in nature but, oddly enough, in certain spiritual lives, it seems to me, they play a large part. In the Orthodox Church tradition there have been many what you would call "crackpots" whose aesthetical life and eccentric behaviour astonished the Christian Church but they were trying to show us that cracks are important to let in the light. They were called Holy Fools. We are all sinners with cracks in our nature and unless we acknowledge them we can never let Christ in. Thank God for Crackpots.

From crackpots to *idiots*. In particular to *The Idiot* by the Russian author, Dostoievski; an author who combined his writing with Philosophy, Theology and Spirituality. He had a great gift for studying human nature and perceiving how society was developing. Here is the quotation which I found set my thoughts wandering:

# Tolerance will reach such a level that intelligent people will be banned from thinking so as not to offend the imbeciles.

It seems to me that a large majority of people today (perhaps it was ever thus) do not want to listen to cogent arguments but would rather pursue their own opinions or as is said - "do their own thing." It is no wonder that the voice of correction or the call for a personal moral life or the upholding of the sanctity of life, should fall on deaf ears especially when spoken by the Catholic Church or Christianity in general.

From crackpot to idiot and to me! In the mirror I see both a crackpot and an idiot but I am not depressed or in despair because I am also able to see the most wonderful miracle of a human life. A life loved and sustained by God as an unique part of His Creation. What is more God does not abandon me in my folly and at my crackpot moments.

Yes! My holiday has made me feel I need much more time and space to be a fool for Christ; to fill myself with His presence so that He takes priority in all that I say and do whether people like it or not.

Let no man deceive himself. If any one among you thinks that he is wise in this age, let him become a fool, that he may become wise. For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He catches the wise in their own craftiness. (1 Corinthians 3:18-19)


