Without His strength, we become very weak, exhausted, and our life cannot reach its purpose. Together with God, however, everything becomes possible. The angel Gabriel said to Mary, "Nothing is impossible to God" (Luke 1:37).

What we celebrate at Christmas is not a fairy tale, a story for children, it is not even a utopia, something impossible, because it is a truth that many can testify (I hope we ourselves too), because they have experienced it. Those who give their lives to be able to go to Mass in Nigeria or in Syria - for example - testifies to us that only God can make our life great. We are not alone, but
