Feeling Powerless?

Raise your hand if you have never felt powerless. I'm sure it's something that has happened at least once in your life. Maybe when you found yourself faced with a situation you can't change, that feels inevitable. Like the sudden loss of a friend or a relative. But also in front of small events you can't control, like, for example, when your little child cries all the time during the night and nothing you do can stop him. Or, when you have planned all of your week in every detail and then you catch COVID and there is nothing you can do except to stay at home and wait...

This sense of powerlessness is something that the Apostles also experienced, after the Ascension of Jesus into Heaven. They would have liked Him to stay with them, in the way they were used to, with his human body, but there was nothing they could do to bring Him back! Nothing upsets people more than having a desire they can't achieve.

Let's go back to the Apostles. Suddenly, "they heard what sounded like a powerful wind from heaven, the noise of which filled the entire house in which they were sitting ... and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit." The situation changes immediately. Before the coming of the Spirit the Apostles were afraid and feeling empty. After, they were "filled" and bold. When we experience a great delusion we lose trust in life, we tend to self-isolate, like the Apostles closed in the upper room. What can save us? What happened the day of Pentecost, when the mood of the Apostles suddenly changed?

After the coming of the Spirit, the Apostles went out, started talking with everyone. They were no more afraid, but courageous and brave. A divine and mysterious power took possession of them. They didn't change, it was the power of the Holy Spirit that changed them. And with this power they can now face every situation. We read in the Acts of the Apostles that they were persecuted, almost every day, to the point of being killed because of their faith. Life after Pentecost is not a life without problems, but it is a life animated by the electric current of the Holy Spirit.

When you find yourself powerless, think about the Apostles in the upper room, and ask for the gift of the Spirit. He won't wipe away your problems, but will give you the strength to face them.
