The Gentle Breeze

Advent is a time when we are called to be childlike, in order to find what we really need: the unconditional love of God. It is this unconditional love that is at the bottom of our aspirations and everything we try to achieve. But why is it that so often we find ourselves missing the experience of receiving this unconditional love?

I believe, from my own experience, that this happens because we look for that love in the wrong place.

There came a mighty wind, so strong it tore the mountains and shattered the rocks before Yahweh. But Yahweh was not in the wind. After the wind came an earthquake. But Yahweh was not in the earthquake. After the earthquake came a fire. But Yahweh was not in the fire. And after the fire there came the sound of a gentle breeze. And when Elijah heard this, he covered his face with his cloak and went out and stood at the entrance of the cave.

1King 19:11-13

The first place where I can see the signs of God's presence, the master of unconditional love, is not my imagination, or the clamour of a *life changing* event, but the gentle breeze of my own life, of my daily routine.

There is a people that witnessed this gaze upon the world, a people that in the history of the world sung the sweetness of this unconditional love that reaches us through every circumstance. Unlike the other ancient people (Greeks, Romans, Assyrian...) the people of Israel identified God not with "something", like an unmoved mover or a projection of human feelings, but with "Someone", an Other, like this psalm testifies.

O Lord, you have searched me and known me. You know when I sit down and when I rise up; you discern my thoughts from far away.

If I ascend to heaven, you are there; if I make my bed in Sheol, you are there.

If I take the wings of the morning and settle at the farthest limits of the sea, even there your hand shall lead me, and your right hand shall hold me fast.

If I say, "Surely the darkness shall cover me, and the light around me become night," even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is as bright as the day, for darkness is as light to you.
