Transfigured by Obedience

When we think about being obedient we often think about orders and commands from our childhood and school days when we paid a painful punishment for not doing as we were asked; for some of us who are older, we remember the physical punishment for being disobedient, while others had to remain after school for "detention" to write out a series of boring "lines" from a book. In other ways we may be reminded of being obedient either through family life - disobeying our parents, or, in professions such as the Armed Services, where orders are given, and those receiving the orders are called to act on them at once!

Obedience is a way of life which is implicit in being a human being and it goes hand in hand with responsibility and living in a society where we bear some responsibility for our behaviour, knowing that bad behaviour can have an effect on other people. We can see the effects of those who are not obedient and what is does to society today. There are rules in place which prevent people just doing what they like. It recognizes that there is a *higher way* of behaviour which leads to a more fulfilled and happy way of life.

In todays Readings we see how this obedience becomes a happiness when it is rooted in following the commands and rules of God. Abraham is called by God to be obedient in a most unlikely way by being asked to sacrifice his son. At the last minute, and when God sees how obedient Abraham is, God prevents him sacrificing his son and Blesses Abraham with the freedom to become one of the greatest leaders of His people, enjoying prosperity and happiness for ever after. The same is true for us. The Commandments and Ordinances placed upon us by Scripture and the Apostolic Tradition of The Church are not there to be a burden or to "chain" us up in "suffocating doctrines". They are designed to free us so that our lives can be lived well and healthily, both physically and spiritually.

The Gospel for today gives us a wonderful example of what obedience can do for us. It can Transfigure us as we become closer to God through obedience to Him. Jesus was the ultimate example and guidelines for our obedience to God. Like Jesus we are called to live this obedient life within a Community which is made up of Believers and those, who, as yet, are not people of Faith. Jesus came down the mountain of Transfiguration and continued His life of witness among all people and asked his disciples to do the same. Our freedom as Christians comes only as people of Faith prepared to live the Christian message in obedience always to what God wants despite what a secular society may require. This may well put us in conflict with the secular powers but that has often been the case and the price we pay for our Faith. St Thomas More puts it well when challenged about his obedience to the King and the State:

" I am the King's Servant but God's first".
