'She has strengthened the presence of Christ in my life'

In one of the previous newsletters, I spoke about the story of Kathleen, a student from the University of Winchester I met last year. I promised to write about her fiancé Roberto, and now I am keeping my promise.

Roberto was a baptised Catholic who had slowly abandoned the faith during his adolescence. Towards the end of secondary school, however, he had an incredible opportunity. His parish priest, Father Dominick, invited him on a pilgrimage to Lourdes as a volunteer. Roberto couldn't afford to go, so Father Dominick paid for him.

«It was there that I encountered Christ for the first time - he told me - in the acts of charity we performed but more fully in the real presence of the Eucharist, carried in procession around the Basilica. I left Lourdes with great peace and happiness. Sadly, Essex, where I grew up, was not as sacred a place as Lourdes, and I subsequently lost my way again until I left home. I started university in Winchester and went to Confession for the first time in almost 3 years and attended my 'first' Mass shortly after. The parish was warm and welcoming, and I felt right at home. I have made many great friends. I had a lot to learn and a lot of bad habits to get rid of, when a blessing came that I could never ask for. I met Kathleen and asked her out without really thinking about faith or marriage. She was amazing, strong, intelligent, and totally in love with God, even though she wasn't a Catholic. I knew very little about the Protestant faith, and because I had fallen in love with her, we decided that discussing our differences would help us grow together in the faith. So, we learned a lot together, and, in the end, she decided that she wanted to convert. I too have decided to receive Confirmation, which I had refused as a teenager. God continued to bless me, because in Kathleen I had found reasons to grow in my faith and in my life. She is the "highlight" of all my days and, in our universal call to holiness, she inspires me to be better and better, slowly but surely. So, I decided to marry her, because she has strengthened the presence of Christ in my life, and she radiates a kindness and a love that I hope to emulate in me one day».

Kathleen and Roberto are together a great witness for me because their testimonies show how the encounter with Jesus and his Church can change us. I am going to celebrate their wedding at the beginning of September. A great joy pervades me in thinking that God allows each of us to have meetings like the one with Kathleen and Roberto.
