Mother of Mercy

The month of May is traditionally dedicated to Our Lady, Mary, Mother of God who can teach us how to follow Jesus with all our heart and mind.

A proper way to spend our time during this month is to dedicate a few minutes each day to pray the Rosary. For some people it is almost impossible to recite all of the 5 *Our Fathers* and 50 *Hail Marys* in the morning or in the evening, because they are busy with many things, although not always worthy of our time (like social media, television, gossip, etc.). My advice to these people is to first consider how they spend their time. Then, if they really don't have time for the Rosary, a good way is to pray a decade (4-5 minutes) in the morning and another one in the evening. In this way, they can offer to God the commitments they face during the day, and thank Him before going to sleep for the gifts they have received that day.

Some Christians manage to pray all the Rosary, but they often get distracted after a few *Hail Marys*. I am no different from them. I like to pray this prayer, especially because I can present to Our Lady all my petitions. However, I have to say that in my experience it is difficult to be focused on prayer for a long time, especially regarding a prayer like the one we are speaking about, which may seem repetitive. What I try to do (before the Rosary) is to think about a person I want to pray for. So, I "dedicate" some *Hail Marys*, or a decade, to that person. Then, I can "dedicate" other *Hail Marys* to another person, or a decade, and so on, and in this way I can pray all the Rosary and be focused in what I am doing. Our Mother in Heaven is pleased to intercede for us and for the people we pray for.

Other people are able to focus their attention on the different mysteries that we announce at the beginning of each decade. I have to say that this is a very good practice, because each mystery reminds us of an important episode of Jesus' life, or Mary's life. And we know that those episodes are not fairy tales, but real events.

What I like about the Rosary is also the final *Hail, Holy Queen*. The words of this prayer are so encouraging. They describe Our Lady as *Mother of Mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope*. They are realistic about our human condition, so often a *valley of tears*. They ask the help of the *most gracious Advocate*.

We can really trust in Mary, because she is always ready to intercede for us with our heavenly Father. She wants to welcome us with open arms. How beautiful are all the images of Our Lady with an open mantle where all the faithful are gathered! Our Lady protects all who fall under her cloak. I want to conclude with some inspiring words by Pope Francis about Mary's mantle;

We pray to Our Lady to protect us, and in times of spiritual turbulence the safest place is under the mantle of Our Lady. She is the mother who takes care of the Church. And in this time of martyrs, she is the protagonist, the protagonist of protection: She is the Mother. (...) Let us state with faith: 'Mother, the Church is under your protection: Care for the Church.' (Pope Francis, homily on 15th April 2013).

MESSAGES CONTINUED



At the Bishops' Conference in Cardiff last week, the Bishops voted unanimously to reinstate the obligation on Catholics to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. This will take effect on Pentecost Sunday. We understand there will still be some members of our congregations who, for reasons of health, do not feel safe enough to return to Mass. It has always been the understanding of the Church that when the freedom of any Catholic to attend Mass in person is impeded for a serious reason, because of situations such as ill health, care for the sick or legitimate fear, this is not a breach of the Sunday Obligation.
