John the Baptist in the Desert

During Advent two figures help our preparation towards Christmas. One is the Virgin Mary just before Christmas and the other is John the Baptist at the beginning of Advent.

This Sunday we read in the Gospel how John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. This happened in the desert close to the place where the river Jordan enters the Dead Sea. During his preaching he said, "Someone is following me, someone who is more powerful than I am." He was obviously speaking of Jesus.

The fact that we start Advent in the desert resonates with us. The desert is a place where nothing is easy and everything is reduced to the essential. The desert is the symbol of our weakness and the hardship of life. At the moment, I think, we all feel that we are in a sort of desert. Even if we have food and water, many of the important things of our life are more complicated. We have just come out of lockdown and the future is still not clear. Some of us suffer from loneliness, others from anxiety and stress. We suffer a sort of desertification of our lives and relationships.

It is precisely for this reason that today's Gospel speaks to us in a more powerful way. In the desert of our present lives when things are tough, we need someone like John the Baptist. He was able to gather many distressed people and help them to turn around and look in the direction of the Lord. He was the one who was able to announce the coming of an extraordinary event. He was the finger that pointed at an awesome Presence, Jesus Christ. Nowadays we need all of this, we need someone to help us in our desert to raise our eyes and find hope. We need a prophet like John the Baptist.

Fortunately, we don't need to travel to Israel to find a prophet. They are around us. God gives us many friends who are able to do what John the Baptist did, who are able to help us to look deeper into our lives, to see that the Lord is coming, that there is more in this life than our struggles and anxieties. Many friends can do this for us and we should do the same for others. We can do that for example by speaking about Christmas but not in a commercial way, for instance by making our Nativity Scene and telling a prayer in front of it with our family, by coming to Mass and confession, by offering our love and compassion to those who live with us.

During Marriage Preparation I am commenting on the first chapters of Genesis with the couples that are going to get married this year. The story of Adam and Eve helps the couples to understand what is love. There is a text we have recently read which says, "Of all the things that arouse wonder, love is the most wondrous. Eve's presence is not so much like a harbour for a storm-tossed ship as it is like the parting of the storm clouds to reveal a wider, more mysterious horizon toward which the ship continues its journey." This text tells us what we should do for each other in Advent. We should point towards the Horizon of our existence. That Horizon who came down from Heaven on Chrsitmas Day.
