WHAT A BLAST!

On New Year's Eve, we waited for midnight by having dinner and a party with several families in the hall of Saint Edward's Church, and I was in charge of the fireworks. I bought some supplies for the occasion at a shop in Southampton, and among other things, there was a fairly large box with a series of rockets that went off on their own once the fuse was lit. That was the centrepiece of the fireworks, so I lit that box at the end of the evening. The box was quite heavy, so I didn't worry about stability. I simply placed it on the ground at a safe distance from the audience and lit the fuse.

The start was very nice, the rockets went off and made beautiful stars in the sky, but at a certain point, while I still had my nose in the air and could hear the explosions, I no longer saw any stars in the sky. On the contrary, someone started screaming. I looked down and saw that the box had turned over and started firing rockets at the people. At that point, I ran towards the box, kicked it so that the rockets would not go in the direction of the audience, and after a few seconds, the box had finished firing.

Thank God it was just a scare and no one was hurt. However, this incident made me think. How easy it is to risk hurting someone without meaning to (this time there were no consequences, but it could have been a serious accident).

It is the beginning of the year and, faced with the risk we took, I find myself thinking that life is not in our hands. We really must learn to rely more on God, to trust in Him.

If it depended only on us, on our skills, on our ability to do things, how much harm would be done, willingly or unwillingly. Pride often leads us to do things we later regret. So this little New Year's Eve incident is an opportunity to put Jesus back at the centre of our life this year too: it is He who saves us from our failures.

In any case, I am not a fatalist. Jesus allows us to make mistakes so that we can grow and improve our way of life. For this reason next time, I will attach the box to a lead plate and anchor it to the floor to avoid another similar incident.

After all, the saying that is useful to live by in this new year is this: live as if everything depended on you, but knowing that everything depends on God. Therefore, do your best and pray asking God's help and protection. Happy New Year!
