What I Had Been Waiting For In My Life Existed!

Some weeks ago I joined members of Communion and Liberation, a catholic movement, from across the world for an audience with Pope Francis.

St Peter's square was very crowded. There were sixty thousand people! Before the thought provoking words of the Pope, some people from the movement shared their stories. One of them was Hassina Houari. Here is her testimony:

Your Holiness, The first time I went to Portofranco, a free study aid centre for students – established in Milan and now spread to 40 cities throughout Italy – I was 15 years old and needed help in English. The first thing that struck me was doing the interview alone, having to tell strangers who I was. But what put me at peace, though, was to see the picture of John Paul II hanging there, kissing an old man. I even said to myself, "How good these people are who have a picture of the Pope kissing an old man on the head!" This image relaxed me, because I was fond of the Pope who had been to Morocco, my mother's country of origin, and who was a person who represented peace to me.

After the interview, I started going to Portofranco and before long I was spending every afternoon there. I had found friends to talk to about everything and who had the same questions that I had about life.

Then one day they invited me to a vacation in the mountains. On that vacation, I realized for the first time in my life that I had not been abandoned, despite the fact that my father had left us when I was 7 years old. After a hike, Fr. Giorgio Pontiggia, who was leading the vacation, asked us, "How was the hike?" and we replied, "Beautiful!"; and he asked, "Why was it beautiful?" No one could answer.

At a certain point, Fr. Giorgio said, "Not even if you all joined together would you be able to make a single pebble out of that mountain, not even a little flower growing out of the rock... the only one who can do that is God." When he said "God" like that, I thought, "So does he really exist?" At that moment I felt my heart burst, and I said "God" with all my heart. It seemed logical to me that it was Him. As if what I had been waiting for in my life existed; He seemed so fatherly and so present! Not someone to be afraid of, judging my evil and my limitations, but Someone who had made that flower growing out of the rock for me too. I will never forget that day; it was June 2009.

Since then a journey to get to know God, that is, the Father, and to get to know myself has begun. In college, I enrolled in Languages and International Relations. I majored in English and Arabic. English was the very subject I had gone to Portofranco for; and I did not speak Arabic even though I was Arab. As a friend told me, it is really true that "when you encounter God He makes you embrace your story." As I grew up, I discovered that that little old man whom John Paul II had kissed on the forehead was Fr. Giussani.

His charism has accompanied me and is accompanying me on the journey of life. It is a great gift; although I never met him in person, he has been God's instrument in my life because he is allowing me to flourish! Thank you.
