Farewell Party

This weekend, a girl from the Student Youth group will be moving to Australia with her family. She joined the group two and a half years ago, faithfully attending our weekly meetings and deepening her relationship with God. She has also made many friends with the other teenagers in the group. To celebrate her departure, we are holding a Farewell Party on Friday (or, since you will probably read this on the weekend, we have held a Farewell Party).

This departure has raised a question for many of the young people in Student Youth: "What now? What will become of this friendship?". This is a question that many of us have had to face in our lives. Whether you were born and raised in this parish and have seen friends or relatives leave for other countries over the years. Or whether, like me, you came to England from another country and left the people you were close to behind. In both cases, we have asked ourselves: "What will become of these beautiful relationships that I now have to leave behind, with whom I have shared my daily life for so long?".

I asked myself this question in a powerful way when I left my friends to enter the seminary in Rome almost nine years ago. I particularly remember the day I entered the seminary. I had asked four friends I had grown up with to accompany me and, early one morning, we left my town, which is north of Milan, for Rome, which is about 400 miles away. Once we arrived, we were together in the seminary, welcomed by the other seminarians and priests of the Fraternity of St. Charles, but in the late afternoon, it was time for my friends to leave. On the one hand, I was filled with joy at this new beginning. On the other hand, being separated from my friends was painful. However, I was certain of one thing: the Lord was asking me to make that separation, and therefore He would not allow those friendships to end.

Now, since that separation on 8th September 2017, I can say that God has not only kept the promise of that intuition, but has given us much more. Even though we have only been able to see each other once or twice a year in recent years — and even less frequently since I moved to England — our friendships have not only endured, but become even more beautiful, true and profound. The reason these friendships have blossomed, as have many others over the years, is one thing alone: if a relationship is rooted in Christ, it contains the seed of eternity within itself. Therefore, even if we have to leave the people we love to follow what the Lord asks of us, such as leaving our friends to follow our family to the other side of the world, these relationships will not only endure, but flourish. Of course, the pain of separation remains, and the nature of the friendship changes: living 5 miles away is different from living 10,000 miles away. However, the truth and beauty of friendship will not fade.

This is the promise that has been made to us: that our friendships, rooted in Christ, will deepen as we follow the path that the Lord has prepared for us.
