'JOY IS THE ECHO OF GOD'S LIFE WITHIN US'

Autumn is setting in and we are having to adjust to the cold, wet and windy weather of the season and darker evenings. All Saints' Day this Wednesday; All Souls' Day this Thursday – and we are launched into November, the month of Remembrance and the harbinger of winter.

The change of season can affect our mood and our behaviour, but so too does the way in which we relate to other people and them to us. We all know the analogy of 'the glass half-full/the glass half-empty' to describe a person's outlook on life. Another analogy contrasts radiators with drains. 'Radiators' are those who give of themselves, enhancing and encouraging others through their joyful and positive attitude; 'drains' are those who leave one dry, make demands and have a negative attitude. Of course, we can as individuals have both 'radiator' and 'drain' times - depending on the many factors and circumstances making up our human complexity.

The abiding quality of a 'radiator' person is their sense of joy, a deep-seated gift within them which transcends all the difficulties they encounter. This can be seen in visiting people whose lives are drawing to a close in a hospice: a sense of utter serenity and trust in the Lord, with gratitude in their hearts. They know that God loves them unconditionally and that the gift of sanctifying grace dwells in their souls. This joy is not a worldly, external happiness or a wish for such but something much more important and lasting. Joy in this sense casts aside the threats of self-pity, worry and complaining in favour of contentment, hope and trust in the Lord.

Many writers have explored the theme of joy. During World War II there was a well-known fictional character 'Mrs Miniver' in stories which succeeded in lifting the spirits of people both in Britain and the USA. The author was Joyce Anstruther, who penned one of our best-loved hymns, 'Lord of all hopefulness, Lord of all joy'. St John Henry Newman wrote a moving prayer of supplication, that we might be 'radiators', in effect radiating Christ to the world:

Dear Jesus, help us to spread your fragrance everywhere we go.

Flood our souls with your spirit and life.

Penetrate and possess our whole being so utterly that our lives may only be a radiance of yours.

Shine through us, and be so in us, that every soul we come in contact with may feel your presence in our soul.

Stay with us, and then we shall begin to shine as you shine:

so to shine as to be a light to others; the light, O Jesus,

will be all from you, none of it will be ours;

it will be you, shining on others through us.

Blessed Columba Marmion, former Abbot of Maredsous in Belgium, is the author of the title above; and Léon Bloy, French Catholic novelist, wrote: 'Joy is the most infallible sign of God's presence'. As we proceed on our earthly pilgrimage, may we, even in our autumnal and wintry times, be the bearers of this joy with the voice of the psalmist echoing in our inmost being: 'I will come to the altar of God, the God of my joy.'


