# Our Vision is a Person, Our Vision is Jesus Christ 2nd APRIL 2023: PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

**Holy Week** 

This Sunday we celebrate Palm Sunday and then we will enter into Holy Week, the high point of which is the Pascal Triduum with The Mass of the Lord's Supper (with adoration of the Blessed Sacrament after Mass) on Maundy Thursday; The Solemn Liturgy of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday afternoon; The Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday and Easter Mass on Easter Sunday. We will be also having Stations of the Cross for families on Good Friday morning.

The Holy Week begins with the festive procession with olive branches: the entire people of Jerusalem welcome Jesus. The children and young people sing, praising Jesus. During the liturgy of Palm Sunday, we listen to the Passion of our Lord. We might ask ourselves a key question: Who am I? Who am I, before my Lord? Who am I, before Jesus who enters in Jerusalem? Who am I, before the suffering Jesus?

We hear many names. Which of these persons am I like?

We hear names of groups: the group of leaders, some priests, the Pharisees, the teachers of the law, who had decided to kill Jesus. Am I like one of them?

We hear the name of Judas. Thirty silver pieces. Am I like him?

We hear other names too: Peter, James and John who understand nothing, who fell asleep while the Lord was suffering. Has my life fallen asleep?

Am I a traitor? Am I like those people in power who quickly summon a tribunal and seek false witnesses: am I like them?

Am I like Pilate? When I see that the situation is difficult, do I wash my hands and avoid my responsibility?

Am I like the soldiers who strike the Lord, spit on him, insult him, who humiliate him?

Am I like the man from Cyrene, who was returning from work, weary, yet was good enough to help the Lord carry his cross?

Am I like those who walked by the cross and mocked Jesus, "You who destroy the Temple and in three days rebuild it, save yourself, if you are God's son, and come down from the cross!"

Am I like the mother of Jesus, who was there, and who suffered in silence?

Am I like Joseph of Arimathea, the hidden disciple, who lovingly carries the body of Jesus to give it burial?

Am I like Mary of Magdala and the other Mary, who remained at the Tomb, weeping and praying? Am I like the centurion who said, "In truth this was a son of God?"

Where is my heart? Which of these persons am I like? May this question remain with us throughout the entire Holy Week.

# <u>Changes to Mass During Easter Week (Mon 10th - Fri 14th April):</u>

**St Edward** - There will be no Masses, no Eucharistic Adoration and no Confession during this period. **St Andrew** - There will be no Mass and no Confession

on Tues 11th April.

St Joseph - Liturgy of the Word & Communion on Thurs 13th & Fri 14th April. Eucharistic Adoration on Thurs 13th April.

Holy Cross - Liturgy of the Word & Communion on Mon 10th, Wed 12th (also Eucharistic Adoration) & Thurs 13th April.

OLQA - Masses as normal.

Communion under both kinds - The Bishops'
Conference of England and Wales have decided that a suitable time for the resumption of Holy Communion received under both species would be at the Mass of the Lord's Supper in Holy Week 2023, given the theological significance of the celebration. We aim to follow that lead in this parish, though we won't be able to offer this opportunity at every Mass for some while.
