Simon son of John, do you love me?

This weekend we can read in the Gospel one of the most inspiring episodes, it is the end of St John's Gospel. Jesus is preparing food for some of his disciples on the shore, after the miraculous catch of the fish. There is an atmosphere of intimacy. At some point he asks Peter, "Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these others do?" This question is obviously addressed to Peter, but it is also addressed to each one of us.

If we want to understand more about this episode that closes St John's Gospel, it is useful to compare it to the end of the Gospel of Matthew, where the last words Jesus addresses to his disciples are, "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." At the end of his Gospel, St Matthew wants to stress Jesus's commandment to go into mission by preaching to everyone and making disciples.

St John has a different vision. He was the one who had the deepest knowledge of the Lord and he understood that what the Lord wanted more than anything was our love. Jesus wanted to be loved. For this reason, St John decided to close his Gospel with this question, "Do you love me more than these?" Jesus asked for love.

St Matthew and St John's visions are not opposed, obviously. They complement each other and tell us that the source of our activity, service, mission and attention for others is our love and affection for the Lord.

In today's Gospel we are told that Jesus wanted as his closest friend not a genius like Paul, not a man of austere penance like John the Baptist, not a man with a great spiritual life or a man with sensational success in his preaching. No, Jesus wanted Peter, because Peter loved his Master more than all the other disciples, he showed that the greatness of man is found in loving Christ. Peter was a simple person, as us all, living a simple life, but he definitively loved his Saviour more than anyone else did.

I would like to conclude with a personal memory. Almost 18 years ago I was in St Peter Square during a Mass celebrated by St John Paul II. He revealed to us that the Lord had asked him in his heart every day of his pontificate the same question, "Do you love more than the others?" And every day he had answered, "Yes Lord you know I love you." And this was the secret of his pontificate!

Let us ask the Lord to give us a true and strong love for Christ.
