But what is a holiday?

For me, it means going to the (sandy) beach in my hometown, Caorle (near Venice), lying on the beach under the sun from 2 p.m. until 6 p.m. at 40 degrees, occasionally going for a swim in the sea to cool off a little.

Then I visit my parents, see how they are, chat with them, cook something for them and let my father cook me some excellent sea bass, one of my favourite fish, which he has obviously caught himself!

The holiday is an opportunity for me to meet up with my friends, to talk about the joys and hardships of the past year, to ask for advice and to eat excellent ice cream together at the 'A Botega del Geato', a small ice-cream parlour run by a friend of mine, whom I met when I was a youngster attending the parish group: his ice cream is the best in Caorle! In reality, I rarely see him now, as the ice-cream parlour is run by his children.

But holidays are not just about relaxation and good food, they are also an opportunity to deepen my relationship with Jesus. Alongside the various leisure and relaxation activities, there is also the daily celebration of Mass, a time dedicated to prayer, and visiting the Virgin Mary in the small sanctuary of the *Madonna dell'Angelo*, located at the end of the promenade along the sea, reciting prayers and entrusting myself to Her intercession.

I have put this point last, but in reality, it is the relationship with Jesus that makes my holiday truly enjoyable. Relaxation and the beach become boring after a while, but the relationship with Jesus is always new and always peaceful. In fact, holidays are a particularly favourable time to devote more time to Him, with good reading, prayer and edifying conversations with friends and family.

I wish you too a holiday that is restful for body and soul, in which you can identify with the lives of Martha and Mary. So look for a good beach (with cold beer, please!) and a good church: they will help you start the new social year rested and full of energy.
