He Gets Us

During the last few weeks a breakthrough campaign is becoming viral. It is a series of television, internet and billboard ads called "He gets us". Two of these commercials will be run during the Superbowl in the US, on the 12th February. If you go onto the campaign's website you can find the vision that inspired it: From loneliness and anxiety, to anger, sorrow, temptation and more, Jesus gets what we go through because he went through it too.

A few days ago a friend of mine suggested that I watch one of those ads. It's called: Al love (Al stand for Artificial Intelligence). The video shows what happens when you ask Al to visualize certain words, like 'Love'. The results are cold, with anonymous pictures that, despite their high resolution quality, don't give you at all that sense of warmth and fellowship that only human love can give.

The ad goes on. They ask AI to visualize love the way Jesus talks about it: "forgiving a friend who has betrayed you", "spending time with prisoners", "feeding the hungry", "eating dinner with outcast", "helping a neighbour in need", "clothing the poor", "a man laying down his life for his friends"... The result is, again, a series of pictures colourful and well done, but faceless and – I have to say – a bit depressive.

The ad ends with these words: "Jesus' love was never artificial".

Al is becoming increasingly pervasive. People working in customer services, for example, will be entirely replaced over the next few years by computers and sophisticated programs that will be more efficient and convenient. Technology is becoming more and more our neighbour, the "person" we ask for advice or help. Are we missing something?

Technology is great, and can make life easier, but there is something it will never be able to deliver: love. The apex of love, by definition, is a relationship between two human beings: it involves all our senses, our reason and affection, our feelings and thoughts. How different it is to meet someone we love in person, rather than online! Perhaps it is more demanding: it's easier to lie to a friend when you are online rather than when you are talking with them face to face. But it's more human! Love is never artificial. Let's not forget this!
