SECOND MEETING TO SHARE OUR EXPERIENCES

Dear parishioners,

Three weeks ago, we had a parish meeting to share our experiences and it was focused on prayer and faith. We were all uplifted by listening to each other's words and stories. All your contributions can be read on our website. I would like to propose a second meeting, this time more focused on **charity and service**.

Over the past two months we have seen many acts of love and service in hospitals, schools, in our cities and homes. At the same time, we may have had some difficulties with other people: we may have lost patience, felt useless, or found ourselves challenged to be with the same person all the time. Personally, I have discovered that love begins with those I live with. I am more convinced that, with the help of God and our good will, our home can really be the beginning of the Kingdom of God.

During these days of lockdown, I found a Sermon by Saint John Henry Newman that inspired me. He says, "The best preparation for loving the world at large, and loving it duly and wisely, is to cultivate our intimate friendship and affection towards those who are immediately about us," and, "The real love of man must depend on practice, and therefore, must begin by exercising itself on our friends around us, otherwise it will have no existence. By trying to love our relations and friends, by submitting to their wishes, though contrary to our own, by bearing with their infirmities, by overcoming their occasional waywardness by kindness, thus it is that we form in our hearts that root of charity, which, though small at first, may, like the mustard seed, at last even overshadow the earth". This Sermon intrigues me, and it makes me reflect about what charity should be.

I look forward to hearing your own stories and reflections. The meeting will be next Friday 15th May at 8.00pm via Zoom. You can prepare for the meeting answering one or more of the following questions:

- What difficulties and challenges do I have now in my relationship with others: family, friends and neighbours?
- What am I discovering about love and charity?
- Am I growing in my relationships with others?
- Have I noticed any gestures of charity/love that I would like to share with everyone?
- What lesson does God want to teach me with all of this?
