1st December 2019: FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

WAITING FOR GOD

This Sunday we begin the liturgical season of Advent. The word advent comes from the Latin "Adventus" and means arrival. But who is coming? And if in this season we are supposed to wait, who we are waiting for?

For us Christians, Advent is like a big and beautiful gate through which we pass to enter a shrine. This gate is flanked by two figures guarding it. They will tell us what kind of shrine we are entering and will ask us to purify our intentions. The two figures are very dissimilar, yet on some old pictures they are found on the right and on the left side of the Expected One.

One figure is a tall man, wearing clothes of camel hair, living on locusts and wild honey. He proclaims a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sin. He wants to be nothing but a Voice.

The other figure is gentle and pure. Her body tells us she is expecting the One. Her words changed our lives forever: "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord".

Both these two figures help us during Advent. We read their stories and we meditate their life during Mass. They are obviously John the Baptist and the Virgin Mary. Both of them know who they are waiting for. They are waiting for no less than God. They are waiting in the certainty that he is actually at the door.

The Virgin Mary knows what the angel told her: "The child to be born of you will be called holy, the Son of God, Son of the most High, and of his Kingdom there will be no end" (Lk 1:31). Unlike the Baptist, who is waiting for someone to appear with fire, with an axe and a winnowing fork, she is waiting for a little child.

Both are waiting for the Coming One. They have a different idea of him, but they have in common the same yearning, a longing that fills their whole being. They wait with such a profound and violent emotion that they do not know how they will be able to face up to the gigantic event that is about to take place.

These two figures are the help Advent gives us to refresh and invigorate our expectancy. We need to be open to the future, to something new. As Christians we know God is always coming and we can live in joy waiting for something God will give us.

Unfortunately John the Baptist and the Virgin Mary are not the only figures during Advent. Zechariah is there as well, with his negative attitude. Even if we don't know completely his thoughts, we know he was punished by the angel: "And now you will be silent and unable to speak until the day this comes to pass, because you did not believe my words, which will be fulfilled at their proper time" (Lk 1:20). He was a man full of disappointment and frustration, a man who had given up hope. "Life has not been good to me", he thought without knowing the plan of God.

We are more like Zechariah in our daily lives. And that is why every year we have this amazing time of Advent to go back to childhood, to go back to expectancy.
