MY KING AND MY GOD

One of the great changes I have noticed over the last twenty five years is the way in which the Faith is handed on to future generations of Catholics through imaginative and engaging Catechesis. The Children's Liturgy encourages our young children to have a familiarity with Scripture; our 1st Holy Communion Children follow imaginative courses to develop a love of the Church and its Sacramental life, while our Confirmation programmes help the Catechumens to answer for themselves their belief in Jesus and His teachings. All these wonderful things are carried out by dedicated Catechists who try to foster a relationship with Jesus which was not so obvious in times past.

Do you remember the Penny Catechism? Do you remember having to learn it by heart and be examined on it? There were a lot of numbers to remember - The Seven Deadly Sins, Four Cardinal Virtues and The Seven Corporal Acts of Mercy and the Ten Commandments. Well the Gospel for the Feast of Christ the King will remind you of the Acts of Mercy as Jesus uses them as hallmarks for those who are on their way to heaven. They are all Acts of Compassion and reflect what is right at the heart of true Kingship. The pomp and circumstance of Kingship epitomised in a Coronation is nothing without Compassion; power and dominion are nothing without Compassion....just think where you see the first sign of the true Kingship exemplified in Jesus. It is written in three languages above his bruised and battered body as he hung on the Cross, but that bruised and battered body is the price of true love for His people. Jesus, full of Love and Compassion, shows in his death what Kingship really means. This is the King who can conquer all through Compassion and Mercy.

In the old Rite of Confirmation a strange act used to take place as you knelt before the Bishop. Just after he Confirmed you he gave you a (hopefully) light smack on the cheek. This was thought to be a form of exorcism to drive out all harmful things. I like to think that it was also a reminder that the price of being part of the Royal Family of Christ the King, His Brothers and Sisters, is to suffer in the act of imitating His Love and Compassion as Disciples. It also earths us in a world which so often tries to stifle the voice of this triumphant message for political gain and utter selfishness by acts of violence.

I am sure that after the Coronation of King Charles III, there was a lot of clearing up to do - a lot of mess needing to be tidied up. You may remember the saying - "After the Lord Mayor's Show comes the dust cart". The two ceremonies go together; the ethereal pomp and the return to reality. The Feast of Christ the Universal King brings these two worlds together - the Transcendent and the Imminent. Lest we forget, Our King loves his subjects in all their conditions even when they think they are worthless.


