HELLO!

Dear parishioners,

I am Mario Toma, the new priest, who belongs to the Fraternity of Saint Charles Borromeo, and who joined the English mission in St Swithun Wells Parish in August of this year. Because of this, Father Raffaele asked me to write briefly about who I am and my vocation.

When I was young I lived in Caorle, that is a village near Venice, by the sea, in the North-East of Italy. After secondary school, I began a University of Padova engineering electronics course, but did not finish it because I found a very good and well paid job instead. So, I had a good job, good friends, a good car, I lived in a good flat; I was almost satisfied with my life, however I felt there was something missing, I wanted to start a family.

During the summer of 1996 I saw one exhibition about the life of Saint Terese of Lisieux. It was the first time that I had heard about her, but the life of this "little saint" was striking for me. A couple of things struck me the most. Firstly, the fact that she suffered because of the bad behaviour of some of the nuns that lived with her, and because of the difficulty of the life of seclusion. Despite this she never complained, on the contrary, she accepted suffering and offered those sacrifices for the conversion of the sinners. In other words she transformed her sufferings into an instrument for doing good, for the glory of Jesus. The other thing that moved me, was that when she died, she was only 24 years old, but she died with a kind of plenitude of life, that although short, gave her prompt entry to Heaven.

When I saw that exhibition, I was 24 years old as well, therefore I began to ask myself: if I die now, what have I done in my life? This was the very beginning of my vocation, because after that, I asked a friend of mine, who was a priest, to help me, and through a path, that sometimes was not linear, at the end I understood the calling of God to be a priest. I entered the seminary of the Fraternity of Saint Charles Borromeo and in 2006 I became a missionary priest.

Now I am involved in a struggle to obtain a work visa and stay here. In any case thanks to Jesus I am here, and if He finds it good that I should stay here, he will help me to go on and overcome the bureaucracy.

Before coming to England I was a missionary in Hungary and in the Czech Republic, and now I am very glad to be here, and to deepen my knowledge about the English culture and traditions. I am sure you will help me in this beautiful journey. God bless you all!
