The Sacred Heart Of Jesus

June is the month dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. It is a devotion that evidently has its roots in the earthly life of Christ himself, but which has spread in the Church above all since the seventeenth century, first through the work of Saint John Eudes and then for the famous revelations received by Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque.

The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus helps to focus on the humanity of Jesus, that is, on how much God the Son, incarnate in the fullness of time, suffered and loved, to open the gates of Paradise. Therefore, it is important to recall all the supernatural meaning of the cult of the Sacred Heart, especially in an era - like ours - which is progressively rejecting the truth that man needs to be saved.

The very close link between the Sacred Heart and the gift of the Eucharist emerges from the revelations to Saint Margaret. The French nun was standing before the Blessed Sacrament when, in 1675, Jesus appeared to her presenting His Heart to her: «Behold - Jesus told her - this Heart which has loved men so much, which has never spared itself, to the point of getting tired and consumed in order to testify to them its love. Out of gratitude I receive from the majority of men only ingratitude, irreverence and sacrilege, together with the coldness and contempt they use me in this Sacrament of love [the Eucharist]. But what is even more painful to me is that, to treat me like this, there are hearts that are consecrated to me».

On the same occasion, the Lord asked Saint Margaret for the first time to ensure that the Church instituted a particular feast to honour the Sacred Heart «on the first Friday after the octave of the Holy Sacrament [...]. On that day you will communicate and pay him a fine of honour, to repair the indignities he received during the period in which he was exposed on the altars. I also promise you that my Heart will dilate and will spread the influences of his divine love in abundance on those who will give him this honour and will ensure that it is paid to him».

Therefore, Eucharist and Sacred Heart are united in a particular way on Friday, the day of Jesus' crucifixion and death. This bond also manifests in another great revelation that the Lord made to Saint Margaret, the one relating to Communion on the first Friday of the month.

Devotional writings are full of stories of sensational conversions - several of them on the verge of death - which occurred in people who had practiced the First Friday devotion perhaps in their early youth and then had distanced themselves from the Church.

Here are the promises that Jesus addressed to the saint: «I promise you, in the excessive mercy of my Heart, that to those who approach the sacred table for nine consecutive months, every first Friday of the month, the almighty love of my Heart will grant the gift of final penance: they will not die in a state of sin, nor without receiving the holy sacraments; and my Heart in those last moments will be safe asylum for them».

So, let us entrust ourselves to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and put all our confidence in its power.
