A Giant In The Faith

I am sure that everyone of us received with great sadness the news about the death of Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI.

I would like to share a few memories that I have about him.

I met him twice, the first time in Genoa (the city where I was born), when he made his apostolic visit to the diocese, and the second time in Rome, when he celebrated a Holy Mass for some priests and seminarians of the Fraternity of Saint Charles.

On both the occasions I had the experience of meeting a man of great humility and tenderness. To summarize, I had the impression of being in front of a saint. I think that many people had the same experience, and this is why many priests shouted "subito santo" ("immediately saint") at the end of his Funeral Mass at St Peter's Square on Thursday 5th January. I had the privilege of being there, and to concelebrate the Mass with Pope Francis. I was impressed to see so many young priests filling the Square, and I am sure they were present because of a debt of gratitude towards Pope Ratzinger.

A few days ago, I read his spiritual testament. I would like to quote a few lines from this text, which I found so uplifting and moving.

When, at this late hour of my life, I look back on the decades I have wandered through, I see first of all how much reason I have to give thanks. Above all, I thank God Himself, the giver of all good gifts, who has given me life and guided me through all kinds of confusion; who has always picked me up when I began to slip, who has always given me anew the light of his countenance. In retrospect, I see and understand that even the dark and arduous stretches of this path were for my salvation and that He guided me well in those very stretches.

I thank my parents, who gave me life in difficult times and prepared a wonderful home for me with their love, which shines through all my days as a bright light until today. My father's clear-sighted faith taught us children to believe (...), my mother's heartfelt piety and great kindness remain a legacy for which I cannot thank her enough.

Pope Benedict thanks his siblings, friends, teachers, and students too. I am so admired to see this clear attitude of gratitude, which is something we are called to as Christian.

Then he thanks his homeland (and his second homeland, Italy), and asks his compatriots to stand firm in the faith. It is impressive to see his humility in the words: I ask for forgiveness from the bottom of my heart from all those whom I have wronged in some way.

The last words of the testament are really his legacy.

I have seen, and see, how, out of the tangle of hypotheses, the reasonableness of faith has emerged and is emerging anew. Jesus Christ is truly the Way, the Truth, and the Life - and the Church, in all her short-comings, is truly His Body.

Finally, I humbly ask: pray for me, so that the Lord may admit me to the eternal dwellings, despite all my sins and shortcomings. For all those entrusted to me, my heartfelt prayer goes out day after day.

The Diocese have been looking to simplify their Charity where it asks for cheques to be made payable to Status, which they have now done. From 1st January 2023, the Diocese is called 'Catholic Diocese of Portsmouth' (previously it was Portsmouth Roman Catholic Diocesan Trust), with registered Charity number 1199568. Our registered address remains the same. What does this mean for our Parish? There is no change to our parish bank account number and sort code, however our bank account name has changed to: CDP St Swithun Wells, therefore please can in St Edward's on Wed 18th January at 1.30pm. you ensure that any cheques written out to the Parish of St Swithun Wells have CDP St Swithun Wells as the Payee. We have been advised that all existing standing orders and direct debits will not be impacted by the new charity name change. Standing Order/ Direct Debit forms and Gift Aid Declaration Forms with the new charity number will be issued by the Diocesan Finance department in due course.
