#### **Easter Joy**

This Sunday we celebrate the most precious event of our lives, the glorious resurrection of Our Lord.

The gospel of the Vigil Mass describes what happened when Jesus rose from the dead. It starts in this way: "When the Sabbath was over, Mary of Magdala, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices with which to go and anoint him. And very early they went to the tomb, just as the sun was rising". In this gospel sentence we can feel the sadness and despair of the women as they approached the garden, the tomb and the place of the crucifixion.

Sometimes we too experience moments of sadness and despair, like these women. We are slaves to our thoughts and feelings. We are imprisoned in a tomb we have created for ourselves. And the reason why we experience such a painful state is because we have removed God from our lives, from our thoughts and from our hearts. Every day we crucify Jesus, we put him in a tomb and we roll a stone against the entrance so that God is so far away from us that he practically does not exist. The stone is the barrier that we put between ourselves and God.

The question those women had was, "Who will roll away the stone from the entrance of the tomb for us?" And the question we have is similar: "Who will help us to remove the stone from our tomb? Who will remove the barrier between us and God?" And the answer for those women and for us is the same: "The angel said, 'Do not be afraid. You are looking for Jesus of Nazareth: he has risen'". Jesus Christ, risen from the dead, was the one who gave joy to those women, and at the same time he is the one who helps us, gives us hope, freshness, enthusiasm, joy.

So, a question arises: "Where do we meet Jesus now? How do we encounter Jesus as a living presence in our lives?" The presence of Jesus comes to us constantly in numerous ways. First of all, I meet him in the living **Word of God**. The Scriptures are not just the words of the past, they are the words that God speaks to us in the present, the Scriptures are the living Word of God. Jesus comes to us now and speaks his words directly into our hearts.

We encounter the living Jesus Christ personally in the **church community** which we believe to be his body. The Church is not a building, the Church is not just a gathering of people, although we are a gathering of his people, his disciples. We Catholics believe that the Church is the presence of Jesus Christ, the body of Christ in our lives. And so when we come together in our church communities to pray and worship, Jesus Christ comes to us. And when we gather on Sunday, we should expect to experience him in a personal way. We come with the expectation of meeting Jesus who comes to us.

We also believe that we meet Jesus in the sacramental life of the Church. When we are baptised, Jesus comes to us and embraces us. When we celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation or Confession, we believe that we meet the living Jesus Christ in the Sacrament. We believe that every time we gather around the altar of the Eucharist, the living Lord Jesus comes among us. The bread becomes his body and the wine his blood and he gathers us to himself. We believe that the risen Lord Jesus meets us in the sacramental life of the Church.

We also believe that the risen Lord Jesus meets us in the lives of our brothers and sisters, especially our brothers and sisters who have experienced the gift of conversion, who have been personally changed by their encounter with Jesus Christ. When we observe the witness of faith they give us, we meet the living Lord Jesus.

Finally, we meet the risen Lord Jesus in our lives of **prayer**. If you and I find a few moments each day to make ourselves available to God, Jesus will come to us and reveal Himself in our prayers.

Let's give thanks for the risen Jesus who comes to us every day. Happy Easter to all!
