JESUS AND BRUSSEL SPROUTS - A Christmas Special

I love the "bling" of the lights and the colour and the excitement engendered by the Festival; I love the food and the culture which surrounds the celebrations. I suppose I must even confess that from a personal work load perspective, I have fewer complicated services to cope with as happens with Holy Week and Easter. Supremely, I love the message of Christmas; the hope and joy that it brings in the message that we have a Saviour born for us who is going to save us from our sins and bring us with Him to eternal life in a place called Heaven. Here is where we shall enjoy the most momentous experience of being in the presence of the One who created us and who wants us to be in perfect happiness forever with Him. Such momentous news should be shouted from the housetops and proclaimed by our media. Unfortunately, the bling of Christmas has obscured the message and we hear very little about the reason and consequences of the Incarnation from the press. Instead, we have the momentous news from the majority of the papers that, Brussel sprouts will be smaller this year because of the summer drought!! What an anti-climax to Christmas - what a missed opportunity. We never seem to hear of the essential teaching of Christmas in terms of its doctrinal implications.

The press seem to compound the misery of a secular Christmas - or should one start calling it the Winter Festival! (We do, to be fair, have our annual Christmas Carol Service and Midnight Mass on the TV). I am so pleased that the Knights of St Columba issue the yearly posters to **Keep Christ in Christmas**. At least we can proclaim that truth as long as the title exists. If I were reporting the earth shattering events of the Birth of Jesus I would use the words of the great writer and theologian Romano Guardini, who says:

The young creature in the stall of Bethlehem was a human being with human brains and limbs and heart and soul. And it was God. Its life was to manifest the will of the Father; to proclaim the sacred tidings, to stir mankind with the power of God, to establish the Covenant, and shoulder the sin of the world, expiating it with love and leading humankind through the destruction of sacrifice and the victory of the Resurrection into the new existence of Grace. So much more newsworthy than the size of sprouts and ultimately more satisfying.

A Blessed Christmas filled with the wonder of the miracle given to us in Jesus be with you all.


PARISH GROUPS
