OUR ADVENT PREPARATION FOR CHRISTMAS

This Sunday begins the season of Advent, the period of four weeks in which we look forward to and prepare for the great feast of Christmas. During this season, we focus on the anticipation of what is to come: the visitation of Our Lord to humanity, both in terms of the birth of Jesus and on the coming of the Messiah at the end of time.

Advent begins a new liturgical year but its significance and importance can be lost in the secular world's rush to push the commercial aspects of Christmas long before the actual event and long in advance of the start of the Advent season itself. I'm sure I'm not alone in being fed up with the assault of Christmas adverts on the television and by the relentless encouragement to spend money on luxury items and food. And never a mention of the true meaning of Christmas!

The beginning of a new liturgical year offers us the opportunity for a fresh start as we prepare for the coming of our Lord and Saviour. The readings for this First Sunday of Advent focus on the coming of the Messiah at the end of time and our preparations for that event. They tell us that the Messiah will bring peace with him and that we should remain focused on preparing the way for him.

For those people on our RCIA programme, their journey towards full communion with the Catholic Church is very much a fresh start for them. And it is a great privilege and deeply rewarding to listen to their testimonials of their journeys into Christian faith. How they have come to knowledge and faith in Jesus Christ and a proper understanding of Christmas. Of how their understanding and experience of the Mass and of developing a prayer relationship with the Lord has changed their lives.

We all need to find ways of entering into the spirit of the Advent season. Meditating on the themes associated with the candles of the Advent wreath might be one way of helping us to prepare. The first candle represents hope, the hope that the prophets brought as they foretold the coming of the Messiah and God's promises. The second candle symbolises the peace that Christ brings to our hearts, our homes and the world. The third candle signifies the joy of Christmas as the birth of Jesus draws near and the fourth candle represents the perfect love of God, revealed through Jesus and the call for us to share that love with others. Meditating on these themes can help us in our prayer during Advent. Being generous in our response to the call for charitable action either through the charities the parish supports or in other ways is also important.

We should all enjoy the opportunity Christmas offers for having a good time and spending family time together. But it is important we do not lose sight of proper preparation and the real reason why we celebrate Christmas. We should be careful not to give in to the relentless pressure to secularise Christmas and ignore Advent. Prayer and the giving of ourselves is important as is taking the opportunity to be reconciled with the Lord through the Sacrament of Reconciliation either during the times set aside in each of our churches or at one of the Reconciliation Services arranged for later in Advent.
