#### Let Your Thoughts Be On Heavenly Things

One of the most significant realisations for me from our parish pilgrimage to Rome came when we were visiting the Colosseum. Our guide had been talking about life during Roman times and that the only people who had rights were the Roman nobility. All other levels of Roman society were to a greater or lesser extent, dispensable. So, most great triumphs were celebrated by executions. Slavery was commonplace and, when a particular Roman emperor wanted scapegoats, they would find people to persecute, like the early Christians.

Christianity brought with it, of course, a very different set of priorities and values. One of the most important was the inherent belief that every single human person has value because they are created in the image and likeness of God. So, all human life is sacred from conception to the grave. It was such a fundamental change that it took a long time to become established. But for most of the last 2000 years it has become a principle on which most legal systems have been based.

But how successfully has that fundamental principle been applied? Compared to only a few years ago, we now have formidable technological, medical and agricultural resources at our disposal. So, why is it that one-sixth of the world's population – or 1.4 billion people – cannot fulfil basic needs, like one meal a day or receiving healthcare? How is it that the richest 1% now have as much wealth as the rest of the world combined? And that's without even mentioning the failure to uphold the sanctity of human life through abortion, euthanasia and conflict.

The readings this Sunday remind us that the only true riches are those that are eternal. As it says in the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading from St Paul's letter to the Colossians: "Let your thoughts be on heavenly things, not on the things that are on the earth." In the Gospel, Jesus tells us that we should guard against avarice of any kind. He goes on to relate the parable of the rich man who had a good harvest and only saw things in terms of his own security based on his wealth.

There is always a danger in getting too comfortable. We all aspire to a good standard of living. But when our possessions start to take hold we should worry because it can harden us against the suffering and needs of others. What we have can insulate us against the differences that exist between those who have plenty and those who don't have enough.

St Paul in his guidance on how to live warns of the things to avoid among which is: "..especially greed, which is the same as worshipping a false god." The reality is that whatever we put our trust in for security becomes our focus of life - so let us make it the living God rather than any false god.


