Walking Together With The Gaze Of Jesus

On the 4th October 2023, Pope Francis opened the Synod of Bishops about Synodality with these words:

We are at the opening of the Synodal Assembly. And we do not need an immanent gaze, filled with human strategies, political calculations, or ideological battles. (...) We are not here to conduct a parliamentary meeting or a reform plan. The Synod, dear brothers and sisters, is not a parliament. The main actor is the Holy Spirit. We are not here to engage in parliamentary discussions, but to walk together with the gaze of Jesus.

The word *Synod* means: "walk together". As the Pope explains, to walk together as a Church means to do it in the company of Jesus through the Holy Spirit. It is not about wandering around aimlessly, but about walking in the direction an Other is indicating us. Who is this "Other"? As St John XXIII said:

First and foremost, it is necessary for the Church to never avert its eyes from the sacred heritage of truth received from the ancients; and at the same time, it needs to also consider the present, which has brought about new situations and new ways of living, and has opened new paths to apostolate.

This "Other", who leads us along the journey, is a person, Jesus Christ, whose identity we can find clearly in the sacred heritage of truth: the Bible, the lives of the Saints, the teaching of the Church's Fathers. Ignorance of our Christian heritage is ignorance of Christ. And ignorance of Christ is ignorance of what "Synod" means.

At the same time, a mere knowledge of the past is not enough. The Church has the responsibility to find ways through which the truth can be communicated today so that people can let their daily lives be shaped by Christ. We have some wonderful groups in our Parish whose aim is precisely this: allowing Christ to shape our lives through our creativity.

Pope Francis concluded his address with these words:

Let's open ourselves to Him and invoke Him: He is the protagonist, the Holy Spirit. Let Him be the protagonist of the Synod! And let us walk with Him in trust and joy.

I invite you in the next few days, rather than discussing about the Synod, to live the Synod where you are, within the different groups our Parish offers.

Let us open our lives to the Holy Spirit and invoke Him, so that He can show us the beauty and give us the joy that comes from belonging to the people of God.
