# SUMMARY OF PARISH FINANCES 2021-2022



The management of finances within parishes is comparable to that of your own families. Our parish generates income each year from which it must pay for all structural aspects of the buildings, all consumables, all personnel and all bigger longer term planned expenditure. Parishes have planned giving which each week or month contributes towards the overall income. Many parishioners add Gift Aid to their donations, this is excellent as it adds 25% to the total donated. Our parish has six churches, five halls, three houses, one flat, grounds and car parks which have to be repaired and maintained, to Government and Diocesan standards. Each year there will be unexpected costs and new ones often arising from regulations or the result of aging buildings.

#### **Financial Oversight**

The St Swithun Wells Finance Committee provide financial oversight for the parish and ensure proper financial controls of the parish assets. The Committee meet quarterly and focus on budgeting, financial planning and monitoring of financial controls, including our income and expenditure.

#### Overview of the Diocesan financial year for 2021-2022 which ended on 31<sup>st</sup> August2022

We submitted the annual returns for the parish's accounts to the Diocese on 31st October 2022.

This year we are reporting the totals of receipts and payments as you can see on page 2. You will see that our payments exceed our receipts by approximately £9,500. Although this is not ideal there was approximately £7,300 of gift aid owed to us on the 31st of August from the small donations scheme, this reduces shortfall to about £2,200. Other significant differences between 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 are summarised below:

### Looking to the future

We have a demanding year ahead and have reduced our building budget from £95,000 to £62,900. We are obliged to pay for Quinquennial inspections and reports this year and any urgent work which arises. The Diocese have increased our Levy by £19,000, which is additional income we will have to find. In addition our utility expenses are to increase and unlike domestic users we do not qualify for any discounts and the energy bill relief scheme is only for 6 months.

Hopefully, you will have had chance to read the Diocese 10 year plan which explains the vision for empowering new larger parishes, like ours, to function as united communities by praying, socialising, fundraising and increasing their shared faith inside and outside the church environment. With this in focus, the New Parish Centre remains a pivotal part of our parish's vision for the future.
