Holy Mass: how to be in front of the Lord

One of us priests some years ago had the pleasure of being invited to concelebrate Mass with the Pope in Rome. He arrived in the small chapel of *Santa Marta* (the place where the Pope lives in Vatican) around 7am when one of the officials told him: "you will have the chance to speak briefly with the Pope after Mass. Now he is praying, preparing for Mass. He always spends an hour in silence before celebrating". After Mass the Pope greeted everyone, one by one, asking personal questions and shaking hands. It is clear that if Pope Francis is a man of dialogue it's because he is first a man of silence. It is from his deep and silent personal dialogue with the Lord that springs his openness.

During a recent general audience, Pope Francis made this point saying:

Praying, as every true dialogue, is also knowing how to be in silence together with Jesus. When we go to Mass, perhaps we arrive five minutes early and begin to chat with the person next to us. But this is not the moment for small talk; it is the moment of silence to prepare ourselves for the dialogue. It is the moment for recollection within the heart, to prepare ourselves for the encounter with Jesus. Silence is so important!

In a recent document, the Bishops of England and Wales said:

Even before the celebration itself, calm and opportunities for silent prayer and reflection have their proper place in the church... Providing opportunities for such calm and quiet is one of the many ways in which a community is able to show hospitality to those gathering for worship.

We have to remind ourselves that the Church is not a hall, but the House where Jesus with his very Body (preserved in the tabernacle) lives. Whenever we enter the Church, during the day or before Mass, there is Someone waiting for us and we are called to be in front of Him with the right attitude.

Another important suggestion about the right attitude to have in front of the Lord, comes again from our Bishops and regards the right posture to adopt at Mass, especially during consecration:

We rise to greet people or to honour someone important... we kneel as a human gesture of submission, humility, reverence and adoration... we sit to listen, to rest, to watch...

Except in case of infirmity it is not usually an appropriate posture to sit during consecration, where a more engaged posture, such as standing or kneeling is to be preferred.

These few guidelines (silence in the Church, before and after Mass, standing or kneeling during consecration) are significant for the good and growth of our faith and understanding of the real presence of Jesus among and before us. It is only for this reason that we would like to invite you to follow them as a community.





Bishop Philip Egan writes:

I'd like to invite the whole Diocese to join me at the Cathedral on the First Sunday of Lent, 1st March 2020 for a Day of Prayer and Reparation for the sins of sexual abuse by members of the Church. The purpose of the Day is to beg God's forgiveness and God's healing as well as to make reparation for the sins and crimes of sexual abuse that have taken place within the Church by and against members of the Church, especially children and vulnerable adults. As we begin the season of Lent, and especially during this two-year period of intense prayer for the spiritual renewal of our Diocese, it seems very important to me that we all have an opportunity to pray earnestly for the victims of sexual abuse and for the forgiveness of those, clerical and lay, who have perpetrated abuse. Over the next weeks, as we finalise the programme, I will give more details. Please keep the date.

Lent Course in Chandlers Ford

The Ecumenical course this year builds on the wide appeal of two Narnia films: 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' and 'Prince Caspian', together with 'Shadowlands', the moving film of C. S. Lewis's later life. Film clips, linked to a saying of Jesus or a Bible passage, will be shown in each session to stimulate discussion on a specific topic. (It is not necessary to have read any of C. S. Lewis's books or seen the films used.)

Five separate groups will be running on two mornings, one afternoon and two evenings. Sign-up sheets are now in the cloister at St Edward's, along with timing and location details of the groups. Everyone is welcome to take part in this enjoyable and worthwhile preparation for Easter. The forms will be collected after Mass on 16th February.
