Sound of Freedom

On July 4th, the movie *Sound of Freedom* was finally released in the United States. A few days ago, it was released in the United Kingdom too, and last Monday I went to watch it in the Eastleigh cinema with Fr Luca, Fr Raffaele, and Fr Mario. All of us were shocked by what this movie described.

The movie is based on the true story of Tim Ballard, the former Homeland Security special agent who dedicated himself to fighting child trafficking and who took his crusade private when he founded Operation Underground Railroad, with the support of Glenn Beck.

The director, of Mexican origins, Alejandro Monteverde directed Jim Caviezel, former protagonist of *The Passion of the Christ* by Mel Gibson, to play Tim Ballard.

Sound of Freedom is made by Utah-based media company Angel Studios, which crowdfunds movies and television shows that "amplify light". Angel Studios is founded by The Church of Jesus Christ of the Latter-day Saints (Mormons) brothers but claims no formal church affiliation.

You can notice a strong Christian tension throughout the plot of the movie. Exemplary is the scene in which Tim (or Timoteo, in Spanish) explains why he is so passionate in fighting against the crime of child trafficking, "Because God's children are not for sale". Or when Tim quoted Luke 17:2 to blame a child trafficker, "It would be better for them to be thrown into the sea with a millstone tied around their neck than to cause one of these little ones to stumble".

Sound of Freedom is a compelling movie that sheds light on one of the crucial criminal horrors of our time, a topic that Hollywood has mostly avoided. On one hand, how many movies and TV shows have we seen about drug trafficking? Too many. Child trafficking, on the other hand, is not a topic that lends itself to "fun".

At the end of the movie, it is reported that child trafficking is the fastest growing international criminal network the world has ever seen. A closing headline states that there are more people enslaved now than there were when slavery was legal.

We cannot take for granted that this movie will be able to shake the consciences of Americans and Europeans. I would like to suggest to everyone to watch this movie (and to stay in the cinema until the end of the credits roll, for an important message of the main actor, Jim Caviezel, who is a practising Catholic).
