## Who Is Coming?

Last Sunday marked the commencement of a four-week journey leading up to Christmas, a period the Church refers to as Advent. The term "Advent" signifies "coming," prompting us to focus on the arrival of Christ. As Fr. Raffaele explained in the previous front page, St. Bernard identified three distinct "comings" of Christ: His historical arrival two thousand years ago, His return in glory at an unknown future time and His continual presence in our daily lives. A Sermon of St Bernard can help us understanding what this third coming, in our present, is about:

If people are unhappy it is because they have abandoned the pursuit of things true and salutary and given themselves up to the search for those that are fleeting and perishable. They resemble the shipwrecked who are in danger of being overwhelmed by the waters, and who may be seen catching eagerly at whatever they first grasp, how frail soever it might be. Thus they perish miserably while following after transitory things and neglecting those which are solid.

I like the analogy of the shipwrecked person. In our lives, laden with commitments, with a strong sense of loneliness and lack of meaning in what we do and live, we may feel physically, emotionally, mentally, or spiritually overwhelmed. We might seek a way out by joining online courses or reading a book, but often they provide just momentary relief. The enduring solution lies in clinging onto something solid, like St Bernard says, akin to the genuine presence of a friend. In my experience only a true friendship can rescue you.

The words of St Bernard can help us again:

[During this time of Advent] meditate on the coming of our Lord. Consider who He is that comes, whence He comes, to whom He comes, for what end He comes, when He comes, and in what manner He comes.

Advent invites us not merely to passively "wait" for the Lord but to actively familiarize ourselves with Him. It makes sense to wait only if you know who you are waiting for.

Becoming familiar with the One who is coming, entails engaging with His story through activities like reading the daily Gospel, finding personal connections within the broader Story of Salvation, and identifying with various Gospel characters. It also involves considering "for what end He comes" and actively participating in His mission, such as performing acts of charity toward those close to us. Lastly, becoming familiar with Jesus means recognizing "in what manner He comes." Just as He arrived 2000 years ago in the flesh, He continues to manifest Himself today through the people around us. Becoming familiar with Him involves embracing the possibility of His presence, which is manifested through familiar human faces: a friend, spouse, children, or colleague, allowing for delightful surprises in those connections.
