## 28th July 2019: SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### One and All - Communion in the Body of Christ

O God, who in the one perfect sacrifice brought to completion the many sacrifices of the (Hebrew) Law, accept, we pray, this sacrifice from your faithful servants and make it holy, as you blessed the gifts of Abel, so that what each has offered to the honour of your majesty may benefit the salvation of all.

This Prayer over the Offerings for the Sixteenth Sunday of The Year dates back to the time when people brought forward small loaves (they used ordinary leavened bread in those days, not the 'hosts' we use today) and small flasks of wine to the Altar for the Eucharist. This rite, which in a big Roman basilica might have taken as much as half an hour, is described in an account of an Easter Sunday Papal Mass dating from about the year 700AD, roughly contemporary with this prayer text.

The document describes how the little loaves were piled up in rows on the altar and the wine poured into large vessels in the Sanctuary. Some of it was drawn off to fill the Chalice that would be consecrated on the altar. Later on, more of the wine was used to fill the many smaller cups used for the distribution of Holy Communion.

The clergy and people who did this understood that they were engaging together in an act that was both sacred and practical. The Lord's altar had to be prepared, his table spread. In outward appearance the Eucharist is a meal. In its substance, they understood that this act encompassed the Old Testament sacrifices in the one single self-offering of Christ which was - and is - the reality at the heart of every celebration of the Eucharist.

These ancient sacrifices, prescribed in detail in the Torah, were ways of engaging with the God of Israel. Now, in the person and action of Jesus, God had come in person to be the sacrifice. Abel was one of his precursors, Abraham and the mysterious priest Melchizedek were others. To this day all three are mentioned together in Eucharistic Prayer 1, the standard Eucharistic Prayer of the Roman Mass.

Christ gave us the pattern of the new and eternal sacrifice: himself. As he took bread and wine and blessed and shared them, he was fulfilling all that mankind had attempted to do in all its ancient rituals.

The people bringing these small loaves and vials of wine also understood that this was a communal act. The offerings of individuals are combined and sanctified on the altar for the whole community's salvation. The Church, Christ's Mystical Body, functions as one single body through the actions of many members, in the act of Christ the Head.

This short prayer expresses a 'theology' of the Eucharist and of the Church, a theology brought to event by Christ in the midst of his people.




