What do we really want?

Everything we do in our daily lives, from waking up in the morning to the decisions that we take, the job we choose, the place where we want to live or go on holiday... What is all of this for? Everything we do is in the hope of being truly happy. But, to be honest, despite our daily efforts, we often find ourselves sad and lonely, unable to guarantee what we really want for the entirety of our unknown future. Everything we do seems too little to fill our expectations.

Only one man in history claimed to be the answer of that thirst for true happiness. His name was Jesus. One could say: "but he lived 2000 years ago. How can we meet him today?".

What is the Church?

The Church is a group of friends who have been chosen to be the Body of Christ in the world. Nothing less than that. Therefore running a ten-session program or focusing on an end product not only would be something against her nature but wouldn't be respectful for the expectations of the people who meet her. It wouldn't be enough. Who needs a course to be happy? Who needs a stunning new product to be really satisfied? Only the Infinite is enough. That's why **the Church can give nothing less than what she is: the lasting friendship of Jesus.**

Now we can understand the real value of the **Sacraments**. They are gifts from the Church and for the Church, never events involving just Christ and me. Their aim is to create a new "we", a new community.

For these reasons, from next September 2019, we have decided to change the preparation to receive **First Holy Communion and Confirmation**. Rather than proposing programs or courses with a beginning and an end, we want to give children and teenagers an everlasting friendship with Jesus within his Body, the Church; that is exactly what they really need.



That's why we are running, starting from September 2019, two new groups for primary school children (*Stars of Abraham* – from school year 3 to 6) and for young people at secondary school (*Grail Seekers* from school year 7 to 9). They will be groups whose aim won't be to prepare people for receiving sacraments, but to discover the friendship with Jesus in every moment of one's life, also through the sacraments.



For those who will be in school year 3 and want to be prepared to receive the First Holy Communion, we'll ask you to come regularly and for one year to the meetings of the *Stars of Abraham*. For those who will be in school year 8 and 9 and want to be prepared to receive the Confirmations we will ask you to come regularly and for one year to the activities of the *Grail Seekers*.

We hope this change brings more happiness to our children and young people. We ask at the same time of the parents some patience, and if you have any questions please come and speak to us without hesitation!
